- 1 Full-Sized Zippered, Backpack
- 1 Folder, 2 Pockets at Bottom Only (Child's Design Choice)
- 4 packs of Crayons, 24 count (**Cra-Z-Art or Crayola**)
- 1 Wide Ruled 1-Subject Spiral Notebook (**Pre-K Students**)
- 1 Washable, Broad Line Markers , 10 count (**Cra-Z-Art or Crayola**)
- 1 **Elmer's** School Glue, 4 oz bottle
- 4 **Elmer's** Glue Sticks- Washable Disappearing Purple, 6 Grams
- 2 Cans of **Play-Doh** Brand, 4-ounce size (Any Color)
- 1 Large Roll of Paper Towels
- 1 Large Box of Kleenexes
- 1 Hand Sanitizer (w/ Pump) 8-12 ounces
- 1 Box of Gallon Sized *ZipLoc* Bags (**Pre-K Students**)
- 1 Box of Quart sized *Ziploc* Bags (**Preschool Students**)
- 1 Container of *Clorox* Wipes *Any Brand (**Pre-K Students**)
- 1 Pkg. of Baby Wipes (**Preschool Students**)
- 1 Water Bottle (Closable, Straw Lid preferred) (filled daily at home)
- Daily, healthy & simple snack (one or two small items) (**See Handbook**)
- Extra set of clothes (Shirt, Shorts, Underwear and Socks) Stored in a *ZipLoc* Bag in backpack

NAP TIME (Extended Care Students ONLY)

Students attending the extended care (full-day) program will take naps in the afternoon. Cots are assigned individually for each child. *Extended Care Students* should bring a **small** pillow and a **small** blanket for nap time. If necessary for sleeping, you may send in a *small, soft 'lovee'* for sleeping. **At Open House, extended care children will be given a reusable shopping bag for all nap time items. Please make sure the items can fit in their shopping bag. Happy Nappers are NOT allowed due to the size and bulkiness.** Every Friday, or the last day your child is in school during the week, nap items are sent home to be laundered. **Please remember that toys from home should not be sent to school.**

Please help us out each morning by tying your child's athletic shoes tightly in double knots or choose Velcro shoes. (**See Handbook**)
